

# Thank You to Those Who Contributed and Pledged to the Capital Campaign!

Sincere thanks to all who contributed and pledged to the Capital Campaign. You helped us reach our goal of raising \$100,000!

Here is a breakdown of the results:

Total Funds Received as of 10.17.2025	\$88,349
Matching Funds Provided by Mission/Benevolence Budget	\$ 5,000
Matching Funds from Endowment Fund	\$ 5,800
Funds Pledged but Not Yet Received	\$ 4,000

Total as of 10.17.2025 \$103,149

Our goal was to raise \$100,000 to support the following projects:

- (1) To replace the air conditioning system which serves the sanctuary.
- (2) To repair portions of our driveways and parking lots. *(completed)*
- (3) To replace or repair portions of the church's roofs. *(completed)*
- (4) To repair and paint some of the outside walls in the Tudor section of the building, which have become quite weathered in recent years.

# Reminder: The 2025 Per Capita Assessment Is \$38 Per Member of the Congregation

What is **Per** Capita?

The per capita assessment is an amount paid annually by each member of the congregation. Our per capita payment supports the work of The Presbytery of Northeast New Jersey, The Synod of the Northeast, and the General Assembly, which is our national body.

In 2025, the per capita assessment is \$38 per member, which is the same as last year. When writing your check (\$38 x the number of confirmed church members in your household) please write "per capita" on the memo line. Or you may use Tithe.ly and indicate that your contribution is your "per capita" payment.

As Timothy Hart-Andersen has written, "Per capita provides the wherewithal for the ecclesiastical democracy of the priesthood of all believers to run smoothly. It fuels the machinery of doing church the Presbyterian way ...." Thank you, First Pres members, for helping us do church the Presbyterian way!

## First Pres Intergenerational Mission Trip 2026

The Mission, Peace and Social Righteousness Team is planning an intergenerational mission trip to volunteer with Almost Heaven Habitat for Humanity in Lewisburg, West Virginia, during the week of July 26 - August 1, 2026.

We have taken two youth trips and one adult trip to Almost Heaven in recent years, and each time participants have had an enjoyable and meaningful experience as they have worked to provide low-income homeowners with a hand up.

While in Lewisburg, we will stay in the air conditioned Rhema Christian Center. The center includes sleeping quarters for men and women, a commercial kitchen where we will prepare our own meals, a gym where youth and the young at heart can enjoy basketball and soccer, as well as individual showers – which isn't always the case when one goes on a mission trip!

Cost is \$200 per participant – which covers our payment to Almost Heaven for materials. The Mission, Peace and Social Righteousness Team will cover the cost of food, fuel and rental van(s) with funds from the Mission/Benevolence budget.

If you plan to participate, please make your commitment with a \$50 deposit by Tuesday, October 28. Checks should be made payable to First Presbyterian Church, with the notation *Almost Heaven Mission Trip* on the memo line. The balance (\$150) will be due by June 21, 2026.
